1. Pertinent Procurement Information

What's in Your Procurement Toolbox – Market Research

Gathering and analyzing information on the capabilities and limitations in the commercial marketplace, as well as determining the best method to obtain the required goods and services. The goal of market research is to better understand the marketplace and suppliers.

Benefits of Market Research:

- Critical to determining appropriate procurement methodology
- Helps identify exact needs
- Keeps project up-to-date on rules and regulations
- Identifies primary and alternative suppliers
- Identifies new and emerging solutions

The Four Components of Market Research

1. **Data Collection** — the gathering of information from internal and external stakeholders and markets to determine the specific needs for a good or service and align those needs with potential products on key factors such as quality, delivery, cost, and other performance indicators.
2. **Market Conditions** - include information about the supply and demand, competition, and distribution of market share in each industry.
3. **Market Capabilities** - the process and result of evaluating if there are enough vendors in the market that can meet the requirements of a project.
4. **Market Intelligence** - the process and result of gathering and analyzing information for unforeseen and future occurrences which could impact a project.

The Procurement Toolbox – Market Research and The Four Components of Market Research information was provided via the National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) and NASPO Procurement U (online education). Please note that suppliers and non-governmental entities are not eligible for NASPO membership and some resources may only be available to NASPO members.

Asbestos Abatement, HVAC Cleaning, Lead Remediation and Microbial Correction Work – Contract Release A-189(5) – Contracts Now Available

The Office of State Procurement has awarded new contracts for Asbestos Abatement, HVAC Cleaning, Lead Remediation and Microbial Correction Work. The new contracts under contract release A-189(5) will be available for all State agencies and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) members starting July 1, 2020.

Product/Service: Bakery Products, Fresh not Frozen – Contract Release B-287(5)

Contract Release B-287(5) Bakery Products, Fresh not Frozen has been extended through June 30, 2021 with an updated Price Schedule which includes additional item selection as well as information about alternative items for products experiencing shortages. Days of availability for each item have been added to minimize cuts and reduce lead time. This contract release is available for State Facilities, State Agencies, and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) Members.

Product/Service: Multi-Function Device (Copiers) Equipment Rental, Purchase and Maintenance – Contract Release C-1005(5) – July 2020 Negotiation Update

The Office of State Procurement is currently negotiating new contracts for C-1005(5), Multi-function Device (Copiers) Equipment Rental, Purchase and Maintenance. The current contracts have been extended through August 31, 2020. If negotiations take longer than expected, OSP intends to extend the current contracts past August 31, 2020 to ensure that there is no lack of coverage. If you enter a lease or maintenance agreement under one of these contracts, the terms remain in effect for the full duration of that agreement, even if the contract itself expires.

Early Cancellation Penalties for MFDs

If your office rents Multi-Function Devices (MFDs) under contract C-1005(5), cancelling the rental agreement before its scheduled end date can incur significant costs. The State contract allows early cancellation of rentals without penalty only in cases of non-appropriation and funding out. If you terminate an agreement early for any other reason, including MFDs idled by Covid-19 'work from home' rules, contract vendors may assess early cancellation fees. These fees can be up to the full balance you owe for the remaining rental period. Specific terms and penalties vary depending on which manufacturer you're renting from (Canon, Ricoh, Toshiba, Xerox), but none permit free early contract termination. Product/Service: MINNCOR Products and Services - Pivots to Produce Personal Protective Equipment – Contract Release M-566(5)

Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the grave need for PPE became prevalent not only for the Department of Corrections but throughout the State of Minnesota. MINNCOR met that need with the production of face masks, face shields and gowns. All incarcerated individuals and DOC staff were provided face masks. Initially, the products were distributed to each DOC facility and more recently made available to Minnesota State Agencies, cities and counties and private non-profits in the state. Wearing PPE items helps keep staff safe and prevent staff emergencies on the job due to inhalation and absorption, and makes for a safer, secure work environment. These PPE items are currently being made in the MINNCOR sewing shops located at MCF-Moose Lake and MCF-Shakopee and the incarcerated individuals working in these shops have produced thousands of gowns, masks, and face shields. Vendor Performance Report Update

The process for submitting a Vendor Performance Report ([VPR](#)) has changed. VPR submissions to OSP will now be completed using the online [Vendor Performance Report](#) form. OSP will then make any adjustments that are needed and convey the VPR to the Contract Vendor. Please see the [ALP Manual](#), Section 4.15.2. for more details.

Updated Templates and Bid Factors - Reminder

Updated Templates for solicitations have been posted as of June 24th. These contain important changes based on feedback from both agencies and vendors. The 3-part structure remains the same: 1) Solicitation; 2) Attachments (to be completed and uploaded by vendor); and 3) Sample Contract and Exhibits. However, text and instructions within each of these documents has changed, so it is important that you use the new templates starting immediately. Significant changes include: * removing Responsible Contractor boilerplate language from the Responder Declarations; * changing text for the Bid Factors used for uploading attachments, * using a SWIFT Bid Factor for Responsible Contractor for construction projects, when applicable (going back to the way it was used before December 2019); and * improved instructions throughout all three documents. Remember, all three documents must be modified and posted with each solicitation event.

Using the Emergency Authorization Form and DocuSign

Please note that your agency must have an active DocuSign account before you can start using the DocuSign tool for Emergency Authorization and other forms. You must email IT.Procurement@state.mn.us to request an account when your agency is ready to proceed with DocuSign; you should also include in the email the names and email addresses of individuals who will be “users” at your agency (individuals who can create and route envelopes).

Contract Release Updates Due to COVID-19

Due to ongoing supply chain issues, back orders, and potential ordering limits related to COVID-19, many of the “must use” Contract Releases have been modified to allow State Agencies to proceed to

another contract or purchase via their ALP Authority without requiring prior Office of State Procurement (OSP) approval to go outside the contract. The agency is instructed to promptly contact the OSP Acquisition Management Specialist/Buyer with any vendor communications indicating unavailable or back ordered product.

To request a Contract Release to be modified to allow for this process, please email the AMS/Buyer indicated on the current Contract Release.
