Web-based Construction Document Distribution System / Quest – Contract Release C-952(5)

The state contract with Quest CDN has been amended to remove the annual subscription feature. Any current subscription will be allowed to run until its natural expiration date. No new annual subscriptions will be accepted after 12/31/2021. Existing subscriptions that expire between now and February 28, 2022, will be allowed to renew for one year.

Update: Freight: Small Package and Express Delivery Services Statewide - Contract Release F-555(5)

Statewide Contract No. 202500 with FedEx Corporate Services, Inc. has been executed and is valid through November 26, 2026. This new agreement replaces Contract No. 117885 which was extended through February 25, 2022. Agencies and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) members are now directed to start using Contract No. 202500.

Statewide Contract No. 121740 with United Parcel Service (UPS) expired on November 27, 2021. The State of Minnesota is negotiating the terms of the new agreement. The State anticipates a delay in executing a new Master Contract; therefore, State Agencies may use their ALP authority to procure delivery services. Non-contract orders should be placed directly with vendors by issuing DPO orders under the market value pricing provided directly by the vendor. Contract Release F-555(5) will be updated on OSP's website as updates become available.

Shredding of Confidential Records – Contract Release S-828(5)

This enterprise contract will be extended through 1/31/2023. The companies have all requested price increases due to the cost impacts they have faced from labor shortages and increased fuel costs. Price increases will be effective February 1st.

Going, Going, Gone! - Minnesota Department of Public Safety (DPS) - Selling Network Security Appliances

Minnesota's Department of Public Safety (DPS) purchased 180 WatchGuard Firebox M200 network security appliances in 2018. The intended project was shelved. 163 of these units have never been removed from the boxes. 17 have been unpacked and gently used. DPS is offering these devices for sale to registered <u>Minnesota Cooperative Purchasing Venture</u> members.

Although the M200 appliances go "End Of Life" and become functionally useless after December 31, 2022, the units retain some exchange value. WatchGuard will accept the old M200 units and give a discounted price on new models, on a one-for-one 'trade-up' basis. These trade-up discounts would effectively reduce the cost of new security appliances.

Boxed units are priced at \$300 apiece. Gently-used units are priced at \$250. Customer pays shipping and handling. These units come "as is," **without a warranty**. If intended for use, they require download of updated software in order to function. (No warranty and no download are required for trade-up exchanges).
