#### 1. Pertinent Procurement Information

#### **Flood Emergency Resources**

The Office of State Procurement of the Department of Administration has many contracts currently in effect that could be a source of materials, equipment and services to assist governmental entities in a time of flood. These contracts provide eligible Cooperative Purchasing Venture members and state agencies the ability to order needed goods and services without having to solicit them as the state contracts have already been solicited. State agencies can order any dollar amount that is allowed by the Contract Release without being limited by their individual delegation of authority.

#### Bakery Products, Fresh not Frozen - Contract Release B-287(5)

The Office of State Procurement has entered into a two-year contractual agreement with Bimbo Bakeries USA for Bakery Products, Fresh not Frozen, for State Facilities, Agencies, and Cooperative Purchasing Venture (CPV) Members. Updated Contract Release B-287(5) including new pricing and ordering options will be posted June 1, 2022.

#### Laboratory Services: Clinical (Statewide) - Contract Release L-229(5)

The Office of State Procurement has executed two contracts under the Contract Release L-229(5) for Statewide Clinical Laboratory Services. The awarded Vendors are Quest Diagnostics, LLC, Contract No. 210828 and Laboratory Corporation of America Holdings (LabCorp) Contract no. 211173. Customers are encouraged to carefully review the information included in the Contract Release before

requesting quotes from the Contractors. State agencies should consult with their agency/division to obtain direction on which provider to consider for the clinical laboratory services.

Waste and Recycling Contracts with Waste Management – Contract Release R-561, R-569, R-625, R-633, R-638, R-674, R-686, R-708, R-712, R-718, W-205, W-222

Some agencies have received the following message from Waste Management: "Our standard Trip charge will be increasing up to \$250 per service. Payment is considered consent to this increase. Please check your service agreement and contact your WM representative with any questions."

Please note that pricing may only be adjusted through a mutually agreed and duly executed amendment to the contract. Agencies who have contracts with Waste Management for waste and recycling services are encouraged to review their most recent invoices dating back to, at a minimum, January 2022 to ensure that trip charges have not increased without an amendment. Additionally, it is recommended that each agency also review other charges included in these invoices and compare them to contract pricing to ensure that contract pricing is being invoiced to the State.

#### Online Learning Solution Services Contract – Contract Release S-901(5)

Statewide Contract No. 85835 with Skillsoft, Contract Release S-901(5), is expiring on July 31, 2022. The State of Minnesota is working through the evaluation phase of the solicitation process. The Office of State Procurement anticipates new agreements will commence on August 1, 2022. State Agencies may start collecting information regarding how many licenses are needed for any future online learning license term. State Agencies may also obtain estimated cost information from online learning solution service providers. However, award information is not yet available, no awards have not been publicly announced and there are no new executed contracts at this time. Contract Release S-901(5) will be updated on OSP's website as updates become available.

# Contract Coordinators - State divestment and prohibition on new acquisitions from Russian and Belarusian entities – Bill HF 4165

This bill passed both the Minnesota House of Representatives and Senate and was signed by Governor Walz. If you currently have Russian or Belarusian vendor contracts (according to the law they must be headquartered or have their principal place of business in Russia or Belarus) the bill requires that all state agencies promptly terminate existing contracts and must refrain from entering into new contracts (RFP/RFB proposals/bids from Russian and Belarusian entities should be rejected) unless the head of the state agency determines that there is no suitable alternative. Agencies are encouraged to consult with the Department of Administration's Office of State Procurement, their agency general counsel, or the Attorney General's Office about any legal compliance questions.

**Question:** How do I Close or Cancel Unneeded Supplier Contracts?

**Answer:** The Department of Administration's Office of State Procurement (OSP) recommends that agencies cancel or close existing supplier contracts that they no longer need. Canceling or closing these contracts streamlines reports both for agencies and for OSP.

- Cancel supplier contracts that have no activity against them. An activity includes purchase orders, receipts, and vouchers.
- Close supplier contracts that have no activity against them.
